## Date/Location:

February $23^{\text {rd }}$ and $24^{\text {th }}, 2024$

ADMISSIONS: $\$ 5$ per person 5 years of age and older with a maximum of $\$ 20$ a family per day or Weekend Family pass for $\$ 30$. Free admission for all players and 2 coaches per team.

Concessions: Concessions will be available during the entire tournament.
Trophies \& Medals: The ${ }^{1 \text { st }}$ place team in each division will receive 15 medals for the team's players and coaches.

MVP MedALs: Rather than an all-tournament team, each team will be provided with an MVP medal to present to the most outstanding player of their team.

## Game Rules:

*Junior high boys and junior high \& high school girls will use a 28.5 " ball and high school boys will use a 29.5" ball.
*Junior high teams will play 6-minute quarters and high school teams will play 8-minute quarters.
*Time between games will be 10 minutes and halftime will be 5 minutes. Times between games shall stay the same unless the game is running 15 or more minutes behind schedule. Only then may times be shortened to 8 minutes between games and 3 minutes during halftime. Additional time may be added between games to ensure no games start more than 10 minutes early.
*Each team will begin the game with three (3) full and two (2) 30 second timeouts.
*Overtime will be three (3) minute periods and each team will have one (1) timeout; no timeouts can be carried over. If the game is still tied after two overtimes there shall be a one (1) minute break, after which there shall be a jump ball and play will go into "sudden death" overtime, with the first team to score winning the game.
*At any time in the 4th quarter (and only in the 4th quarter) if a team is 30 points ahead, there is to be a running clock for the remainder of the game. The clock stops only for timeouts and injuries.
*Every team needs to be at their assigned gym 15 minutes before their scheduled starting game time, suited up, and ready to play.
*For player safety, no basketballs will be allowed to be dribbled along the sidelines during games.
*For protection of the facility, no basketball (or any ball) dribbling or passing will be allowed at any time outside of the gyms.
*Only players with immediate upcoming games are allowed on the court.
*Teams, please meet at center court prior to the start of the game to pray together with the home team responsible to lead.
